The response from our first issue was overwhelming. The comments and questions sent in from you, the TurboNation, helped create the exhilarating new issue. I hope you enjoy it.

TurboGrafx-16 Breaks 4Mb TurboChip Barrier

hey said it couldn't be done, but now it is becoming a reality.
Although NEC has the only available 16-bit CD ROM player which offers 5200 megabits (650MB), people who don't own a TurboGrafx-CD system have requested a TurboChip with more than 4Mb of memory.

Raiden is the first TurboChipbased game to offer 6Mb of power. The year is 2090 and alien forces have invaded Earth. Top aerospace engineers have analyzed wreckage from enemy planes to develop "Raiden." "Raiden" is technically superior to any aircraft on earth and only the best pilot can hope to handle it. The entire world is depending on you!

This unbelievable shooter blows the competition away with realistic backgrounds, more colors, more enemies on screen, and more game play than ever thought possible. Blazing Lazers is child's play when compared to Raiden. NEC has packed this arcade hit into 6-MEG of uncontested excitement.

A FANTASY JOB: THIRD PARTY

eet Victor Ireland. Have you ever fantasized about becoming a publisher of hot video games? Victor and his company, Working Designs, have just become a brand new third party publisher and this fall will produce two great new games for the TurboGrafx-16 System: Cadash and Parasol Stars.

If you are a hard-core gamer, you must have dreamed at least once about publishing your favorite Japanese games or having them published in this country. Some of these dreams will just be dreams; however, Victor has made the dream come true.

How did he do it?

Victor is a professional computer programmer by trade. Some of you might have seen his writing about video gaming on CompuServe Information Services, Prodigy and GEnie. His interest in the console gaming systems and the technical aspects of how they work started his writing about the 16-bit systems and their games.

Because he is officially a computer programmer, he is very familiar with the hardware of the 16-bit console systems, and through his research, he became aware of many potential software deals. He discussed this with his partner, Sylvia, and they decided to take a shot at becoming a third party publisher. "Why didn't we choose Sega or Nintendo?" asked Victor, "From my standpoint, there are simply too many Sega third parties to support such a limited base. And, on the Super NES, there were already too many people on the SNES bandwagon to justify our getting on, too. We wanted to choose a platform where there was plenty of great foreign product available for licensing and where we could stand out." TurboGrafx-16 was the platform.

Currently his days are spent translating Japanese to English, evaluating new games, staying in touch with industry contacts, managing his sales reps, and getting manuals, boxes, and advertisements ready to print. "This particular pro-

ject has 'sidetracked' me from the programming end of things, which is a nice change."

Everyone should know that becoming a third party publisher is not easy. If it were easier, many people would be publishers by now. We asked Victor what difficult experiences he has faced as a third party publisher. He said "becoming one" was a bit of a challenge. "In the beginning, we had no product. NEC Japan did not want to make us a third party until we could tell them which products we were going to publish, and the Japanese PC Engine software companies would not talk to us about licensing until we were a third party. Kind of chicken or egg thing. Eventually, NEC Japan issued a statement to the Japanese software companies to which we were talking to the effect that we would be a third party as soon as we licensed a product - this seemed to satisfy them, and we began serious negotiations."

Victor continues,"Another challenge was in getting the various revisions of the games to test in a timely manner. Customs can hinder you, tying up EPROM (pre-production) versions of beta test copies sent to us from Japan for at least two or three days. I came up with the great idea of having the source files transmitted by modem to our offices where we would transfer them to EPROM for testing. After much trial and error, we figured out the problem and ended up transmitting the files at 2400 baud, which took about 30 minutes each time."

All his challenging efforts worked and two of his games will be published as scheduled this fall. Let us tell you about his games:

Parasol Stars: Bubble Bobble III retains many of the features that made Bubble Bobble (BB) Land II so popular. both here and abroad. But, it adds many new features. Rounds are bigger on the screen on the higher levels. so the screen can scroll left or right, unlike BB I. In addition, there are 4 different kinds of Mega attacks, Water, Fire, Lightning and Star. The Mega attacks can be triggered when you collect 5 small bubbles with your magic umbrella. The basic scenario is that you have to save 8 planets (including yours) from the evil minions of the evil Chaostikahn (K aws ti con). The game has 10 levels, each with 7 rounds, one ending at level 8, and one ending after defeating Chaostikahn at level 10. In addition, there are lots of power-ups and secrets to unlock. The 3 meg game will ship in October, and has a suggested U.S. retail price of \$59.99.

Cadash is a virtual carbon copy of the Taito arcade game of the same name. The only thing missing in the Turbo version is the timer. You still have four characters to choose from before you start your quest to save the King's daughter, Princess Sarasa, from the evil Baarougue. Each character (Fighter, Priest, Mage, Ninja) has different weapons and magic abilities, making the game fun to replay with different characters. The game also has a two player simultaneous mode (using the TurboTap), which also changes the way the game is played. The graphics in this game are some of the best in any PC Engine or TurboGrafx-16 game right now, and Turbo owners should be very happy with the amount of play value they'll get. The U.S. version of Cadash is 4 meg, will ship in November, and has a suggested U.S. retail price of \$61.99.

video taping in Chicago at a video production house. My game playing sequences then get edited down, and are used in our TV commercials."

"Andre Panza Kickboxing is very realistic and intense. Ys III-Wanderers from Ys is a great sequel with cool end bosses. Raiden is real exciting, since it's a 6 meg shooter with lots of fast action."



I am a proud owner of a TurboGrafx-16, but I have a question which I have heard many versions to which is, does the TurboGrafx-16 have a 16-bit processor? Another question, does TurboGrafx-16 have the same capabilities as the Genesis, or is it in some aspects better? If you could set me straight on this subject I would be very pleased.

The TurboGrafx-16 has a 16bit graphics processor that provides for bigger characters, more colors, and more moving objects. The number of bits in the microprocessor is really not relevant. It's like asking which has a bigger engine – a dump truck or a Ferrari. To excel at entertainment, game machines need high powered 16-bit graphics, not number crunching microprocessors. We're moving a large number of colorful characters quickly around on the screen of a TV, not solving simultaneous differential equations. Therefore, the speed of the microprocessor is much more important than the number of bits that it has. TurboGrafx-16 has a faster processor (1.5 MIPS, Million Instructions Per Second), than Genesis (.70 MIPS). Speed is much more important than the bit count in video games. This allows for better, smoother gameplay. TurboGrafx-16 can move graphic and screen data faster than Genesis which greatly enhances gameplay. As for the other aspects in which Turbo exceeds Genesis, TurboGrafx-16 has the TurboTap which allows up to 5 players at once. Genesis can only allow 2 players. TurboGrafx-16 has a handheld -TurboExpress – which uses the same software. You can take all of your favorite TurboGrafx games on the road.

And then there's the TurboGrafx-CD Player – the future of video gaming available first for TurboGrafx-16.

I've recently read an article in Electronic Gaming Monthly saying, "NEC has announced that the CD-ROM system card will be upgraded from 64 kbits to 2 Megabits. It will be called the 'Super System Card' Version 3.0." Can TurboEdge give us more information on the "S.S. Card?" When does it arrive in stores? Do we have to buy a whole new CD-ROM unit with the "S.S. Card?" I hope you can answer these questions. Thanks a lot.

The "Super System Card" is a memory card that will be introduced for the PC Engine-CD in Japan this October for a retail price of \$74. It adds 192K to the present 64K, giving 256K (2 megabits) of RAM. This means developers will have more memory to create more fun and challenging games. The card will be sold separately, so to upgrade the CD-ROM system, all that's needed is the new "Super System Card." All the CD software is upwardly compatible from the original CD to the Super CD. We expect to announce plans for the U.S. introduction of the upgrade card soon.

I am really considering buying your "TurboBooster," but I have a few questions. Do I have to have a VCR hooked up to my TG16 system? Also do I have to hook my system to a stereo for better sound? All I really need is a more detailed description of the "TurboBooster." Keep up the good work!

The TurboBooster is an audio/video adapter that provides direct video and stereo sound (with direct hook-up to your stereo receiver, TV or VCR) which lets you enjoy all the great music and sound effects packed into every TurboChip game card! And it delivers sharper, clearer video, adding a new dimension to game play. The TurboBooster provides stereo sound with stereo TVs or with mono TVs in combination with your home stereo audio

NEC has developed a new video compression technology New Interactive Display (NID)

- designed to be used for multimedia in both the office and home. NID technology incorporates 100 to 1 video compression that provides full-motion, still pictures and stereo audio. NID will have the ability to work with either the TurboGrafx-16 video game system or PC/At compatible computers. This technology allows you to enjoy interactive multimedia that incorporates "live video." Applications include entertainment. education, information, training and more. However, this is only a technology at this time and it will be a while before NID will be a part of the TurboGrafx-16 video game world.

You guys are the greatest! I was excited to see TurboEdge in my mailbox. I opened it &

read it immediately. I'm glad that I can be kept up to date for free. I have one question about the TurboExpress to be answered in Q&A in TurboEdge. I've noticed there is an antenna port (or maybe video in?) which the TV Tuner adapts to. I know the TV Tuner takes in the signal and converts it to a tuned signal for TV. I was wondering since a VCR doesn't send a tuned signal, can you hook up a VHS VCR to the TurboExpress? That would be the ultimate Turbo INVENTION!!! I was also wondering if the TurboExpress offered a screen protection cover sold separately?

In addition to broadcast TV, you can watch your favorite video cassettes on the TurboExpress screen by using the TurboVision TV Tuner. Just connect your VCR to the TurboVision A/V port using a Twin-RCA-To-Miniplug connector (you can purchase one at any electronics supply store) and you're ready to watch your videos. Your TurboExpress-TurboVision system can also serve as an extra monitor for your camcorder allowing one person to operate the camera and another to hear and watch the action in color. All VCR's and Camcorders are different, so please refer to your manual for proper connections and converters. We do not have a screen protection cover; however, you could purchase a carrying case (several are available from third party manufacturers) to protect the entire unit.

When you purchase the TurboGrafx-CD player (\$299.99 U.S. retail price) you will get the docking station, the CD-ROM unit, a system card, A/V cables, a new, larger AC adapter and a carrying case. The TurboGrafx-16 System (\$99.99 U.S. retail price) is needed to operate the TurboGrafx-CD player, but both units are sold separately.

I have two questions. The first is about the CD system. Is the CD player a standard CD player? The second is about the TurboExpress. I have not been able to see one yet and I wanted to know if it is an LCD TV or a picture tube TV screen?

The TurboGrafx-CD player is actually a CD-ROM unit. It has all the features of a regular audio CD player plus the capabilities of reading and storing information. This is why our system can play CD games and music as well as the new CD+G (Compact Disc + Graphics) music discs. The TurboExpress handheld has a high resolution, active matrix backlit color LCD screen with 238 x 312 resolution. Game Gear has only 30% of the resolution of TurboExpress and Lynx has only 20%. Furthermore, TurboExpress can display 512 colors while Lynx and Game Gear can display just 16 and 32 simultaneous colors on screen respectively.


